




# Directional Antennas


# SA150.5



The antenna SA150.5 is designed for base radiostations working in bands of 146-157 Mhz. It can be used for receiving and transmitting till 200 W. The antenna has a directional radiation pattern, is broadband and that is why it is suitable for duplex operations.

Constructionally it is designed as a five-element YAGI, made of aluminium alloy and on the surface it is covered by polyester colour. During the lightning strike the antenna is protected by a galvanic connection with the tower. The wind resistance is 150 km/h.

The antenna is connected to the coaxial cable by the coaxial plug "N" type which is soled together with this antenna.
